Why are there no water bowls?

Members are encouraged to bring their own water bowls for their dogs.

Contagious respiratory diseases/viruses in dogs are most commonly spread by air born particles from coughing or sneezing infected dogs but it is possible for your dog to be exposed to pathogens when communal water bowls are contaminated regardless of how well they are maintained.

The best way to protect your dog from any potential risk is to have your own water bottle or collapsible water bowl and avoiding communal water sources.*

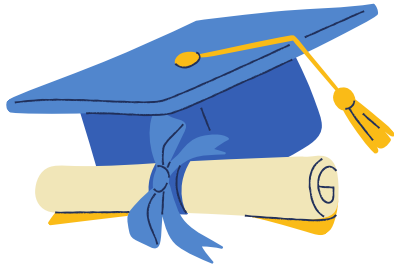
Should you forget to bring a bowl, single use disposable bowls are available from the registration desk.

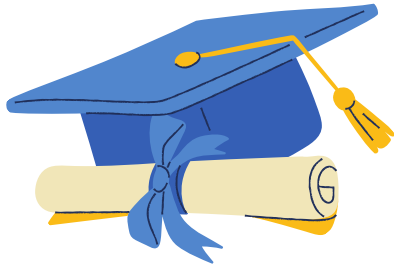

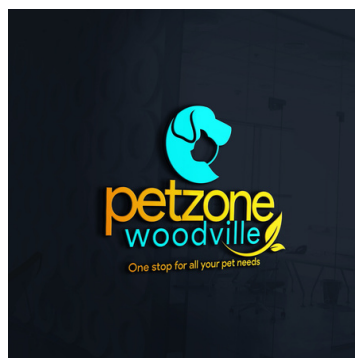
